
have a problem, please let us know). Art work can be picked up from 10 am to 4 pm

As you look over the new 2016 exhibition calendar included in this newsletter and begin planning your entries for the Winter and Spring shows, I'd like to bring to your attention some changes that Ameriserv Bank has recently made in its policies for exhibitions in its gallery space. One is that it will no longer allow free-standing, three dimensional sculpture to be exhibited, due to the small space and the risk that someone may run into it and be injured, or that the art itself may be damaged. (Problems with damage have occurred in the past.) However, wall-hung relief sculpture is still acceptable. The other change is that the bank reserves the right to remove any work from the show that it deems offensive or inappropriate. As they are a business serving a wide range of the public, and they kindly allow us to use their space at no cost, we feel we should honor these requests. In this newsletter you will also find our proposed slate of AAJ officers and committee chairpersons for 2016, and

you might notice some unfilled positions on the board. We are a small group---currently just over 100 members---and it's increasingly difficult to find enough people to fill these positions. We realize many of you are very busy or live too far away to attend meetings, but if you do have some time and interest, we'd really appreciate your getting involved.
