We also provided the awards for the Greater Johnstown Young Artists Exhibition, on view at the Community Arts Center until May 29th. It's wonderful to see the creativity and enthusiasm of local art students and dedicated art teachers!

Our next event is our members only, non-juried Summer Show at the Community Arts Center in June, for which you should already have received a prospectus. This is always a very popular show, and we look forward to seeing you on June 6th with some new and exciting work to enter.

#### ACOA – Just the Facts

Although you have probably heard about the ACOA at some point over the past few years, some of you have asked what is this organization and what is its primary function. The Arts Coalition of the Alleghenies (ACOA) is a collective group of artists and arts organizations among Cambria, Somerset, and Bedford counties, all looking to jointly promote and protect the arts community.

In 2011, a committed group from within the arts community funded a survey to evaluate the impact of the arts and culture in the region. The objective was to strengthen and promote artists and the arts. From the results yielded by the survey the ACOA was formed as a non-profit collaboration which supports the arts in all its forms, the visual and performing arts. The mission of the Arts Coalition of the Alleghenies is to collaboratively schedule, market and advocate for the arts community in the Allegheny region. The ACOA works together with its member artists and arts organizations to encourage complementary programming and cooperative promotion efforts. For artists – that means maximum visibility. For art lovers that means the ability to find out about all of the area's classes, exhibits, and performances in one location.

In 2012 Allied Artists became a member of the ACOA. As a participating partner, AAJ (and other partners) benefit in several ways. ACOA members receive joint marketing efforts and influential promotional efforts. AAJ's website is linked to the ACOA website offering maximum social media exposure with links to our Facebook page and our quarterly e-newsletter.
